DO YOU KNOW THE LENTEN REGULATIONS? Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligation days of fasting and abstinence, which means one full meal each day and abstaining from meat both days; All Fridays during Lent, if you are between the ages 18 and 59 are to fast and abstain from meat; ages 14 to 18 abstain from meat. Those that are physically or mentally unable are excused, as are pregnant and nursing women.
