FALL DINNER REPORT – Sales and donation income totaled \$8,799.00 and expenses were \$4,261.75, for a total of \$4,537.25. Part of the profit we will tithe to various organizations in our area. The carpet in the church is complete. The total cost of the carpet and installation was 5,858.73 (carpet: \$4,605.73 + installation: \$1,253.00). The sacristy will be carpeted later this fall, approximate cost will be \$750.00. The carpet was purchased from Mason Tile and Marble and was installed by Scott Walker who works with them.

HAWKEYE HARVEST FOOD BANK is always in need of food donations and especially during the upcoming holiday season. Please leave donations in the baskets in the back of church. Thank you to all the people who continue to make donations. It is always appreciated when I bring the items up to the food bank. The last donation weighed in at 40lbs.

SNOW REMOVAL – We are still in need of someone to move snow for us this winter. It needs to be done on Sunday mornings by 7:15am. Since we are not using the front entrance to the church at this time that would not have to be cleaned that early. The sidewalks and the parking lot would need to be cleaned by 7:15am. Must be at least 18 years old, and have insurance to cover your work. Must have your own equipment – snow blower for sidewalks and bobcat for the parking lot. BLACKTOP on parking on south and west side of Parish Center cost was \$11,655.45, which was paid out of parking lot funds. The estimate on the parking lot blacktop is \$88,000.00, which we hope to get done next spring. The balance of the parking lot fund after paying the \$11,655.45 bill is \$51,763.88. THANK YOU to Frank Kelly, an engineer from Heartland Asphalt, for doing a lot of the grading of the parking lot, which he did not charge us for; our bill would be higher if not for that donation.
