Volunteer mentors will receive training from Catholic Charities and can expect to spend 2 to 3 hours of time weekly meeting with the client. Over 90% of individuals released from jail or prison will return to their communities, many without employment, housing, or a support system, so mentors are essential to the reentry process.
