SCRATCH CUPCAKES – The Mason City Area National Catholic Youth Group has been given a special opportunity to sell cupcakes from Scratch Cupcakery to raise funds for their trip this fall. We have \$74,179.45 in our parking lot fund, so will be borrowing \$13,689.60 from our memorial money to pay the remainder of the bill.
