Income from the dinner and food sold was \$9,467.00; the expenses to date are \$9,107.51, not a large profit. We had \$3,470.00 in turkey donations ahead of time, so that will be our profit from the dinner. **MANY THANKS** to all who gave a donation, especially to Johnson & Sons Tiling of Aredale who gave a \$250.00 donation, they did work for one of our parishioners who happened to mention the dinner donations to them. It never hurts to spread the word! **THANK YOU** to all who worked to prepare the dinner – starting with coleslaw on Tuesday night, dressing on Friday and Saturday, and to serving it on Sunday and to those who helped with the clean-up. Many hands make light work they say!! Lots of compliments on the food.
