**TURKEY DINNER REPORT –** We served 775 dinners, which was down from the 1000 we were planning on, but still a great number of meals. INCOME: Meals \$9467.00, Food sold: \$329.00, Turkey donations: \$3515.00 for a total income of \$13,311.00. EXPENSES: Turkeys: \$5550.09, Potatoes, gravy, corn, cabbage, dressing ingredients, and dinner rolls: \$2881.40, Paper products, \$738.45, Advertisement: \$23.40; Postage to mail letters for donations: \$51.62 for a total expense of \$9244.99. Income of \$13,300.00 minus expenses of \$9,244.99 = profit \$4,066.01. From that profit we tithed \$650.00 total: \$100.00 Epiphany Baby Pantry; \$50.00 to the following: Catholic Charities, Crisis Intervention, Dominican Sisters, Presentation Sisters, Francis Lauer Youth, Hawkeye Harvest Food Pantry, West Fork Food Pantry, Women's Shelter, Rockwell Fire Department, and Rockwell-Swaledale EMTs. Thanks to everyone who helped and especially those that took over getting everything organized and running smoothly. Without you, this would not ever happen.
