**CHURCH TUCKPOINTING** – The accepted bid for the tuckpointing of the church is \$51,500.00 to replace 100 bricks, if more need to be replaced it will be an extra \$20.00 per brick, and for the sealing of the brick on the Church and Parish Center, it will be an additional \$4,000.00. Work should begin this spring or summer. We will need to raise money for this project. At this time, the parking lot is paid for so if you wish to use your parking lot envelopes for tuckpointing, please just cross off parking lot on the envelope and make note of tuckpointing. Starting with the May mailing of the budget envelopes, there will be an envelope marked tuckpointing. The finance committee is working on other ideas to pay for this project. The profits from the fish fries that the KC's and Guild are doing will go towards the tuckpointing fund.
