**MEMORIAL** – Sacred Heart received a memorial in the amount of \$2,000.00 from the estate of Margaret Ann Campbell Sturges. Some of you may remember her, she was a parish member here from 1924 until 1957.

**TUCKPOINTING PLEDGE CARDS** are being handed out today. Please consider making a pledge. The cost of the tuck pointing of the church and the sealing of the church and parish hall is about \$55,000.00. This work is scheduled to be completed this fall. The finance committee decided this would be a good way to get funds to pay for the project by this fall.

**PARISH COUNCIL ELECTIONS** will be on Sunday June 5th. We have 3 council members whose 3 year terms are up but they have chosen to run again. They are Colleen Barnes, Kim Thyne and Jim Rooney. We also have Tony Laudner who has decided to run for council. The term is for 3 years and the meetings are held every other month on the first Thursday. This is a good way to share your talents with the parish.

**FISH FRY RESULTS** – Income for the four fish fries was \$6,988.00. The expenses were \$3,734.54 for a profit of \$3,253.46. This money will be put towards our tuckpointing project. Thanks to the Knights of Columbus for organizing the fish fries, to the Guild who furnished bars, and to everyone who worked at the fish fries! Lots of great compliments heard from people who came to eat.

**IRISH FAIR** – Income was \$27,447.50. The expenses were \$6,830.30 for a profit of \$19,837.20. That is the largest profit we have had for the Irish Fair as far back as anyone can remember. The auction was double what we usually make. The donations were awesome. Thank you to everyone for their generous donations. This money pays for our Religious Education programs in our parish and also for the extra tuition we pay for students going to Newman Catholic Elementary School (this offsets the tuition rate difference between the lower Mason City Parish tuition rate and our Parish's, as an outlying parish, tuition rate). The additional 50/50 Card Raffle brought in \$780.00 to go towards our tuck pointing project. If you would like a copy, Income/expense reports are on the table leading into Parish Center.
