GUILD UPDATE - The Guild met last week and discussed the many things. Kitchen items: We purchased 6 new large cake pans for our kitchen, as we were often borrowing from another church to supplement our supply. We also purchased 12 new roasters and 4 new inserts. The inserts in some of our roasters were chipped, etc., and it did not seem fitting to serve food out of them. It is difficult to find inserts at this time and the shipping costs are expensive so opted to buy entire roasters and were able to get free shipping from different companies. The total of these items came to \$1,094.99. The Knights of Columbus contributed \$300.00 towards the cost. *Divisions*: We added new members to our divisions. Kaylin Rueth and Sydney Gruman to #1, Merlena Henderson to #3, and Deb Kelley to #4. Prayer Shawls: Joleen Anderegg showed us a shawl they use at the church they go to in the winter in Texas, everyone liked it. Deb Kelley will contact those who seemed interested in prayer shawl committee. Carpet: The insurance inspection man asked us to get the carpet checked in the church as some of the ends seem to be loose. Working with Mason City Tile & Marble to see what can be done. Upcoming events: Bob & Marilyn Ermer asked us to serve a breakfast for their 70th wedding anniversary on September 24th. It will be after Mass as usual and everyone is invited. Several divisions will work on the breakfast. Cookie Walk on December 17th after Mass. Same as in the past, asking everyone to bring 2 dozen cookies and will sell for a free will offering. Turkey Dinner: The Dinner date is October 29th! Mark your calendars. Marilyn Ermer is donating a quilt again this year for the Raffle. Discussion on the price to charge. Last year was \$12.00/meal but with the rising costs, we will need to increase the cost. The cost of turkeys will be \$0.50 more per pound this year, which is about \$500.00 more. Cost of paper products will be higher. We will cut back on number of pies but stay with apple & pumpkin. Menu will remain the same but will go back to shredding our own cabbage and making the same dressing we have always made. SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE met on August 24th and the following was discussed: Caring Pregnancy Center Bottle Campaign - to date we still have 13 bottles not accounted for so please look around your house to see if one had been misplaced or multiple were brought home by different members of your family. We would like to be able to bring back the rest of these so that more do not need to be purchased as this bottle campaign is a big one for them and many churches and other organizations do this for them every year. There doesn't have to be a donation in them, we are hoping to just get them returned. This campaign did give the Center \$2,797.99 was the total with 87 bottles returned.
