SACRED HEART SCHOLORSHIP FUND –The Parish Finance Committee has suggested we start a scholarship fund for the graduating seniors from our parish each year. The Parish Council approved the project and are hoping to get this started in the near future. All graduating seniors that plan to go on to further their education would be eligible for the scholarship. All they would have to do is let the committee know of their plans. We would use the interest earned on the funds for the scholarships and depending how many seniors we have is what the actual scholarship would be. They plan to use some of the Religious Education money received from the Irish Fair funds. The funds would be invested with CFAD, a Catholic foundation in the Archdiocese of Dubuque.
