Guided by the feedback received from parishioners across the Archdiocese, the Core Team is now reviewing input and parish data to prepare recommendations for Archbishop Thomas Zinkula. The final pastorate plan and priest assignments will be announced this spring. Beginning in July 2026, each new pastorate will begin with an interim six-month Mass schedule as parishes prayerfully discern how to work together in mission, unity, and love. The Archdiocese is also developing resources to help with parish collaboration, evangelization, and renewal.
