**LENTEN REGULATIONS** from the Archdiocese of Dubuque – Catholics are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays during lent. Additionally fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, with only one full meal and several smaller meals, not to equal a full meal allowed on these days. These regulations are designed to deepen spiritual practice and connection to the Church during this holy season. It is a symbolic way to remember the sacrifices of Jesus Christ.
