PARISH HISTORY: In 1890, Fr. Burns started a campaign to raise funds for a new church to meet the needs of the expanding congregation. Work began and that year the foundation was completed and the cornerstone was laid by the end of 1890. Much of the material was hauled from Mason City by Parishioners. Labor was donated. Due to a shortage of experienced brick layers, the structure was not completed until the spring of 1892. The dedication took place November 10, 1893. The Church was dedicated in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This was a point in history when it was necessary to change the name from St. Columbkill's. Why? In January of 1905, the 13 year old church caught fire and burned to the ground. A campaign to raise money to rebuild was started. With the cooperation of priests, parishioners and the Bishop, a bigger and better Church was built on the site of the former church. All the bricks were donated by the Walsh family, the altar dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary donated by John McGaharen family, the main altar was given by the Hugh McLaughlin family. The cornerstone was laid in April 22, 1907. The first Mass was celebrated in early 1908. In 1878 there were 40 families. This is our church today. Now we are talking a new roof. Would that be the one that is on now?

There was a misunderstanding with the company who prints the envelopes. When the mailing comes out with the March/April envelopes, the Maintenance Fund envelope will say "Church Roof" and the regular building envelopes will be back as they were before. Sorry for the mix up! We are starting a Church Roof Fund so when we have to replace the Church roof, we will have funds to cover the project.
